other children and adults happy through her caring actions. words and Isabelle has achieved so much this term because she is excited to learn and thoughtful and





To keep ourselves safe and To achieve

A couple of weeks ago we thought again about 'How to keep ourselves safe'. The children really impressed me because they had all remembered that the colour of the lanyards the adults wear mean different things. They know that an adult wearing: blue means staff, green means a safe adult to work with alone and red means they should not be on their own with that adult. We also discussed e-safety and all the children know that they should 'ask before they watch' anything online and if they see something online they don't like they should tell an adult that they trust. They all made a poster to advertise this and the winning ones were added to our safety display on the stairs.
