refusing to move on a bus. The children were surprised to hear that, in the past, in America black and white people had to sit in different sections of a bus. One day, Rosa sat amongst the white people and was arrested because she wouldn't move. Fortunately, lots of people were outraged by her arrest and the law was changed so today there is no segregation on the buses. A massive achievement! The children spent their week thinking about their own achievements - of which there were many.

This week it is Diwali and Mrs Khurana spoke to the children about how Hindus celebrate this festival. In class the children have been showing how resilient they are, for example when: challenged by a maths problem, learning to spell a word or learning to

write a new letter in handwriting. As we know the children at Deer Park are known for their resilience so








News from your PTA
