### Place Value

Count in 1s forwards and backwards across 100 from any given number, count in 2s, 5s and 10s

Read and write numbers in words to 20

Give the number that is one more or one less than a given number

### Addition and Subtraction

Know and use number bonds and related subtraction facts

Understand the symbols +, - and =

Add and subtract a 1 digit number to a 2 digit number and solve one step word problems

### Position and direction

Practice describing where something is and then give it instructions it to move—forwards, backwards, left or right.

Be able to take quarter turns and half turns

## Science

### Materials

Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials.

Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

### Seasonal Changes

To think about the changing of season from Autumn to Winter—What do you notice? Think about: the changing weather, the length of the day, what happens to the trees and how the animals cope with the changing season.

### Working Scientifically

Test materials to find out which material would make the best post bag. Make observations and carry out a simple test.

Identify the countries that make up the United Kingdom

Locate London on a map of England

Use the terms North, South, East and West

Follow a route
