We have been using 'The Romans: Gods, Emperors, and Dormice' to learn about Roman myths. This week the class used descriptive language, past tense and adverbs to retell the Roman creation myth. Next week the class will be learning the story of Romus nad Remus and plan their own Roman myth.

This week we have been learning to round to numbers to 10 and 100. The class used their knowledge of multiples of 10 and 100 and number lines to round.
