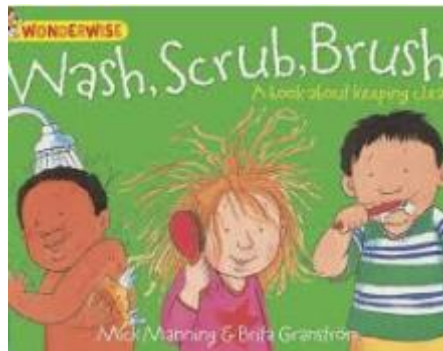


Friday 11th October 2019



Next week we will be reading the book 'Wash, Scrub, Brush' and we will be talking about the different ways that we look after our bodies.

In literacy we will read the story and we will use sound maps to begin to hear and write the initial sounds in words while we are drawing pictures of the different ways that we stay clean.

In maths we will be measuring our hands and feet using unifix cubes.

In topic we will be reading 'Handa's Surprise' as part of celebrating Black History Month. In our carpet session for this we will look at a picture of Handa in her environment and we will talk about the similarities and differences between her environment and our own. In our books we will draw and write about fruits and foods that we enjoy.

On our Welly Walk we will use natural resources to make a picture of a person.

Come and ask for more if you use them all up!



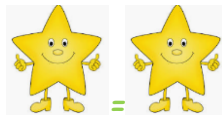
Show and Tell
