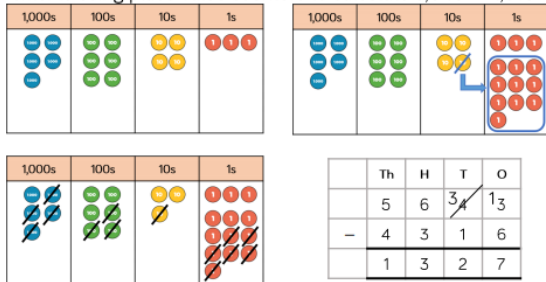
This week the class researched the Romans and made their own leaflets. After researching the features of a leaflet the class chose three topics and created a colourful and informative leaflet

Maths

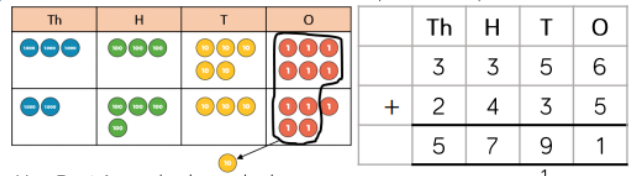
This week the class have been reviewing addition and subtraction with exchanging, and began to add and subtract four digit numbers. It is essential children continue to use the place value grid, as shown below to understand why they are exchanging and not just 'putting a one underneath' without

understanding why and how they are exchanging 1s, 10s, or 100s.
