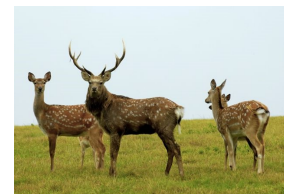


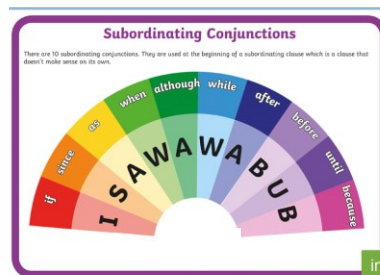
Sika Class Newsletter
