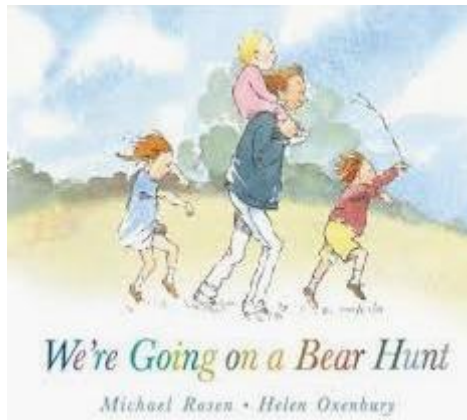
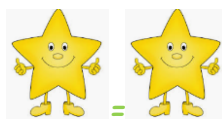


*Friday 17<sup>th</sup> January*

*We change all books on a Friday, please make sure that books are returned each week. For books that are not returned after two weeks we will ask for a small donation towards replacing lost books.*



*Don't forget to keep reading the Red books that are coming home each week, please do write in the yellow reading record book to let us know how they are getting on with it!*
