Maths—Multiplying using the informal and formal methods

This week the class have been learning to multiply 2 digit by 1 digit numbers using an informal and formal method. I have assigned Mathletics work related to multiplication.

'One pack of biscuits costs 84 p. How much do six packs cost?'

Example working 1:

$$\begin{array}{r} 84 \\ \times 6 \\ \hline 80 \quad 4 \end{array} = 504$$

$$80 \times 6 = 480$$

$$4 \times 6 = 24$$

$$480 + 24 = 504$$

$$3 \times 32 = ?$$
